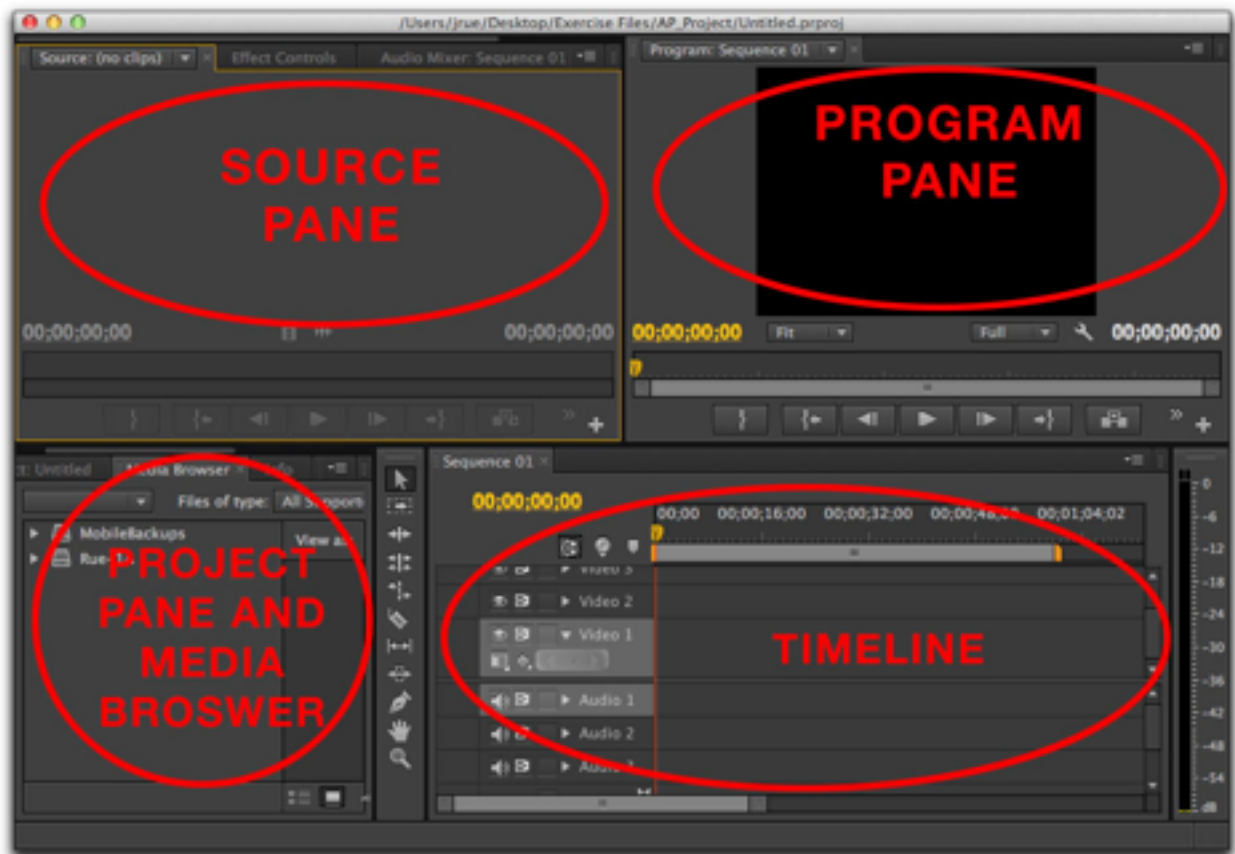


Premiere Pro Editing



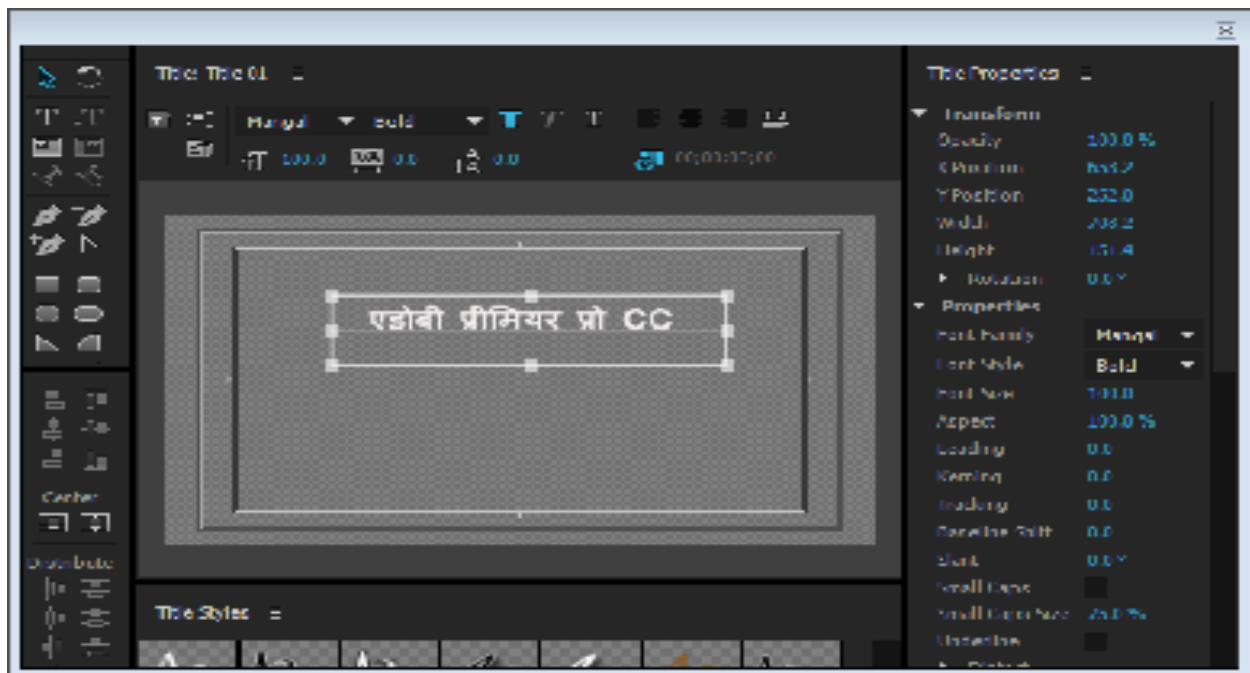
IMPORT

1. Save clips to folder on desktop
2. EJECT SD card and return to container with SD cards
3. Open Premier and Start a new project or OPEN your existing project. (ALWAYS label your project with Period first, then name of project.)
4. CHECK to make sure you are editing on YOUR project and not another period.
5. IMPORT clips into project.
6. Clips will be in the Media Browser. You can click and make them in ICON mode which will show you a thumbnail of your clip.

EDITING:

1. Double click on clip and it will appear in Source Pane
2. Set an IN marker and/or OUT marker to select the desired amount of time
3. Drag from Media Browser to Timeline
4. Use the Razor Blade tool (shortcut: B) to cut down clips in your project.
5. Select the unwanted clip and use Backspace on your keyboard to delete it
6. If you made a mistake and wish to undo it, hit "Command Z" on your keyboard to revoke your mistake

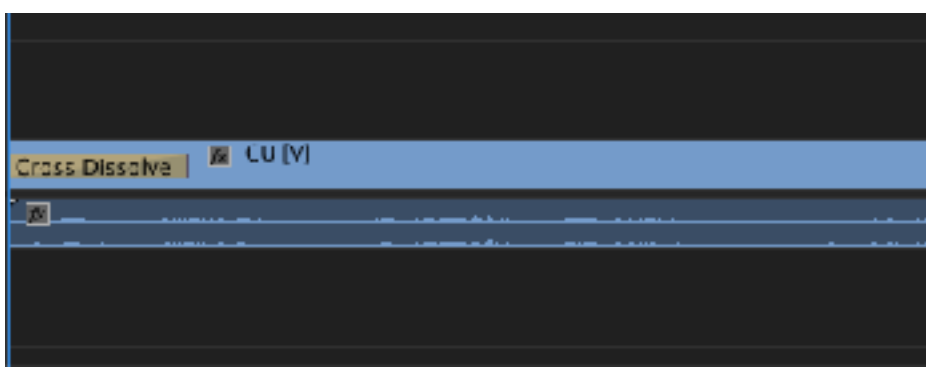
TITLES



1. To add a title, on the top of the screen, select Title
2. On the drop down menu, hover over “New Title” and select “Default Still”
3. Click “OK”
4. On the top left of the new title window, select the capital “T” near the arrow tool
5. Click on the screen and type out your title
6. When done typing, select the arrow tool at the top left and adjust the size and placement of where you want your new title
7. If you want to change your font, select the left hand drop down menu above your title and select the desired font
8. When done, exit the title window and drag the title from the Media Browser onto the timeline.

EFFECTS:

1. To add a Fade to/from Black at the beginning and end of your video, click the “Effects” tab
2. In the search bar, type “Cross Dissolve”
3. Click and drag the effect onto the desired clip



4. To adjust the length of the effect, click and drag the effect to

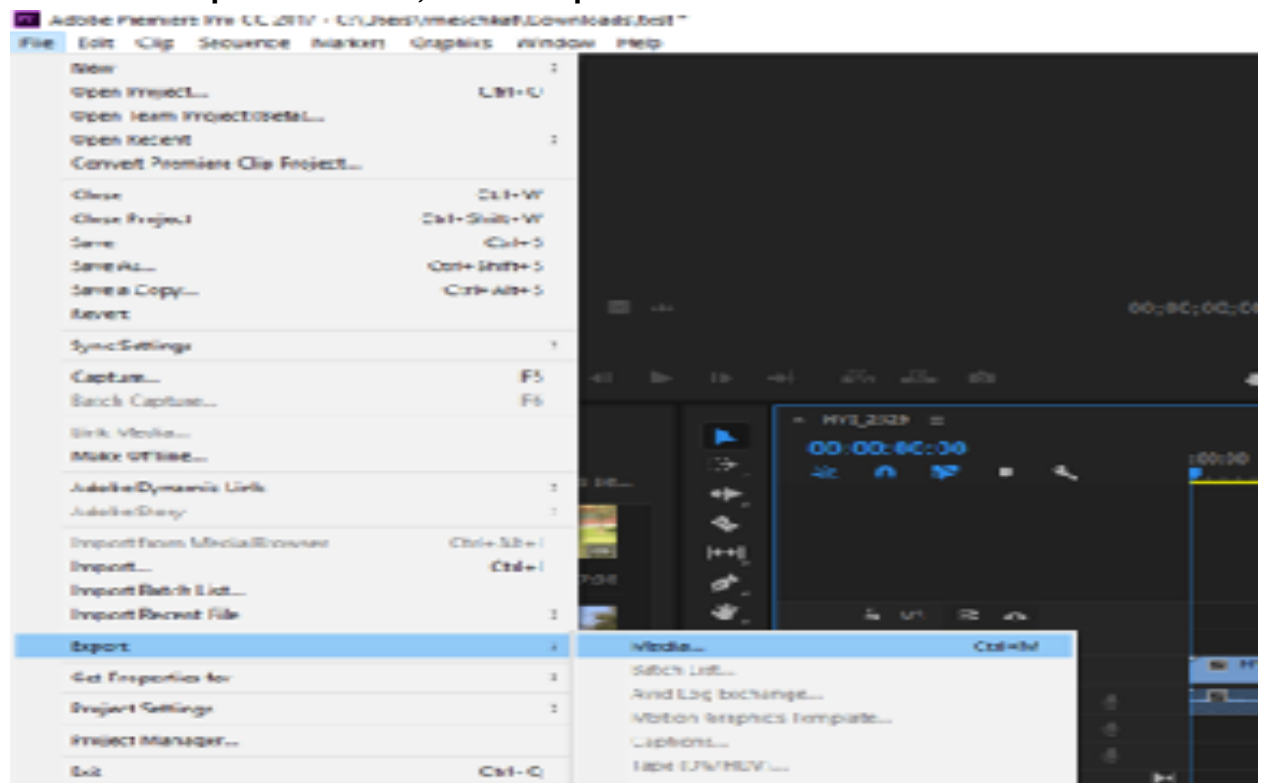
desired length

Music

1. Sign in to your gmail account
2. Go to youtube.com and click on your icon up at the top right hand corner of the screen.
3. Select Creator Studio
4. On the next screen, select Create on the left hand side of the screen.
5. Choose the song you want and download it. Make sure you save it in your project folder and then import it to your project.

Exporting

1. Make sure to render and save your project. Then select your timeline.
2. Got to File menu at the top of the screen.
3. From the Drop down menu, select Export and then Media.



4. From the next window, change the Format, Preset and File Name.
5. The Format should be: H.264

6. The Preset should be: Vimeo 720p
7. Change the name to your project and **SAVE IT** in your project folder on the E Folder!!
8. Press Export at the bottom of the window
