

# FINAL VIDEO 1B

## California State Standard:

- *English (10-11) Standard 2.1 – Writing Applications – Students will write fictional narratives that explain location, sequence, and other details while also pacing the action and descriptions.*
- *English (10-11) Standard 1.7 – Listening and Speaking – Students will use props, visual aid, and other electronic media to enhance their oral presentations.*
- *Visual Arts Standard 2.1 – Creative Expression – Students will create original works of art with complexity and skill using a variety of media to reflect their view.*
- *Visual Arts Standard 5.1 - Connections, Relationships, Applications - Students will be able to design an advertising campaign for a video production completed on campus – using images to represent characters and the events taking place.*

## Assignment:

Create a video 2-4 minute short story. The subject of your story can be your choice, as long as it is complete. You can choose to make a comedy or a drama – as long as the plot includes a conflict for the protagonist to solve. Because the movie will be short, the conflict should be rather simple and clear.

You must complete the following:

1. Develop a treatment form for the following theme You must use the following:
  - Theme: “Tomorrow is another day.”
2. Develop a plot and conflict that uses the theme.
3. Complete a treatment form and storyboard and a script (SCRIPT will be extra credit).
4. Individual treatment form and storyboards are worth 100 points of your individual grade (DUE – MAY 4th and 5th).
5. Choose one from the group and re-create a treatment form and group storyboard.
6. Create a GROUP SCRIPT
7. When storyboarding avoid boring camera angles.
8. Do your filming in an area where other classes won't be disturbed.
9. Edit footage.
10. Create a 30 second movie trailer with VO to get viewers to want to see your movie.
11. Complete a Poster for your movie.
  - Poster should be on nice poster paper.
  - Should be in nice printing and in color.
  - Come up with one or two sentence catch phrase for your movie to put on poster.
12. EVERYTHING IS DUE: MAY 19TH.

## THINGS THAT ARE DUE:

- 1) Individual Treatment form and storyboard, and optional script.
- 2) Group Treatment form, storyboard and Script

- 3) 30 second Movie Trailer.
- 4) 2-4 Minute completed video.
- 5) Poster for your movie.
