Run, Lola, Run Essay

- 1. There are subtle changes in each of the three runs—especially in run number -- how does this relate to the theme of chance?
- 2. What is the reason for the emphasis on spiral symbols? (i.e. animated sequence at beginning of film, the spiral decoration on the building behind Manni's phone booth, etc.)?
- 3. What is meaning of the various changes in the photo montages? How do they relate to free will versus determinism, chance or the butterfly effect?
- 4. What is the meaning of Lola's three screams—especially the third scream? You need a strong unifying element. Look at the different themes of the film.
- 5. In what ways is this film a love story? You need strong points of interest.

*Remember, scenes cannot be points of interest because they're pieces of supporting evidence.
